- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

#### ANSWER

### THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR STEEL

(a)to(c): The Government doesn't interfere with the free and fair trade of the steel products. However, Government of India takes trade remedial measures to avoid injury to the domestic steel sector following due process. Following trade measures have been taken by the Government in FY 2017-18:-
